

Kids' Harbor Reopening Plan Summary

(as of 8.30.20)

In-Person Programs

All children need to be registered and spots need to be reserved weekly.

September 13: Nursery and Preschool/Kindergarten Bible school begin (limited spots)

September 16: Wednesday KK and Club programs begin (For Club programs, grades 4 & 5 only to start; hope to add younger grades a couple of weeks later.)

September 27: Elementary Bible School begins (limited spots)

Health and Safety Protocols

- All children must have a signed waiver on file. This is part of the registration process.
- Self-Certification for Families and Volunteers
- Physical Distancing, PPE, and Safety Guidelines
 - All areas:
 - Masks are required for anyone ages 2 and up.
 - Limited personal items. No strollers.
 - Everyone must wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer before entering KH.
 - No snacks or food, only closed drinks and bottles.
 - Only one parent from each family is allowed in KH, and the same parent will be requested to both drop off and pick up their child(ren). Elementary kids can be independently released.
 - Parents are asked to bring children to the bathroom before class.
 - Nursery:
 - No diaper bags are allowed, instead bring supplies in a labeled Ziploc bag or be ready to put items into one when you arrive.
 - Preschool:
 - Physical distancing on carpet areas is helped by the use of Velcro floor spots. 6-foot tables have a chair at each end.
 - Elementary:
 - Physical distancing of 6 feet or greater is used in classroom seating.

Classrooms will be multi-age to best utilize larger spaces.

Sunday Schedule

- Only 9:30 Bible School and nursery will open initially on Sunday.
 - 9:15-9:30: Screening and Check-in
 - 9:30-10:30: Class
 - 10:30: Parent Pick up and Prompt Exit
- Parent options:
 - 9:30 service in sanctuary (reservation needed) or adult community
 - 9:30 KH parent connection in CL02 to visit with other parents and attend 11 am service as a family

Wednesday Schedule

- Kids Korner: 9:15-10:15 am
 - Clubs: 6:45-8 pm
- Parents must accompany kids to the Commons Lobby for drop-off and screening.
